Are not the scriptures in the Bible enough to teach us that living sin-free is possible right NOW in this present world? **YES!**

Q. Who should we follow?

“For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth.” 1 Peter 2:21,22

Q. Why were the scriptures given?

“My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:” 1John 2:1

Q. How can we be kept from sinning?

“Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee” Psalm 119:11

“Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus.” Philippians 2:5

Q. Did Jesus teach sin-freeness?

“Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.” John 5:14
